

DISCIPLINARY ACTIONS

Any violation of the Troop 97 Behavioral Policy will be dealt with on a case by case basis. The level of disciplinary action will be determined by both the Scoutmaster and Troop Committee. If the circumstances are of serious nature then immediate dismissal from the Troop may result. Any youth violation involving alcohol, drugs or tobacco products will be considered serious.

It is not our desire to enforce such measures against any one of our Scouts or participating adults. But, **this policy is in effect for all individuals of the Troop at all times.** We will make every effort to correct any behavioral issues prior to administering this policy. However, we are prepared to do so should it become necessary.

Disciplinary actions that will be considered are:

Verbal warning.

Conference with the Scout or adult.

Conference with the parents of the Scout.

Removal of the Scout or adult from a Troop Meeting or event.

Suspension from participating in a Troop Meeting or event.

Dismissal from the Troop.
